THROWING I

Pottery Wheel Basics for Beginners
WITH DUANE CLAIRIDGE

8 WKS 20 HRS If you're interested in learning how to work on a potter's wheel, this is the course for you! This introductory ceramics class will explore the process of wheel throwing and various applications to create simple forms on the wheel. Students will be taken through the process step-by-step, beginning with wedging clay, centering and throwing forms, and finally glazing and firing their work. 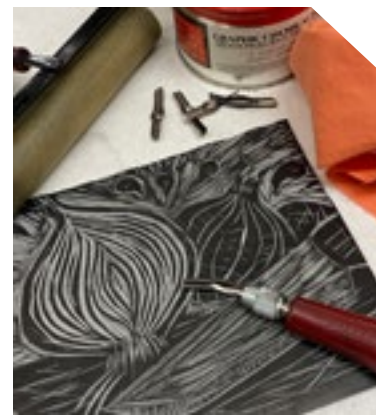
IMAGE MAKING

With Lino Cut

WITH KOURTNEY BARTEL

8 WKS 20 HRS This 8-week course will explore the process of image-making with lino cutting processes. Students will learn the basics of composition to suit the linocut process, then cut the lino and print their own plates to create their own unique prints. Safe cutting techniques, proper inking methods, along with edition labeling and press usage will be taught.

Must be a current AGSM member and have knowledge of the AGSM print studio through previous class experience.

DRYPOINT

WITH KOURTNEY BARTEL

8 WKS 20 HRS In this course, participants will learn the ins and outs of drypoint intaglio, a technique first developed in Germany in the 1400's for reproducing artwork for printing. Students will explore this method through introduction of tools, plate preparation, drawing transfer, inking, paper preparation, and press use. Finishing techniques such as colouring, along with the proper methods of edition labeling, will aid students in completing their prints and bring them to completion.

Explore colour theory and how to apply it to your portrait, using pencil crayons to layer colours to achieve expressive eyes, glowing skin tones, and more. A great class for improving your drawing skills and developing your portraiture abilities.
