## 6-9 YRS 9-12 YRS CARTOON & ANIME STORYBOARDS

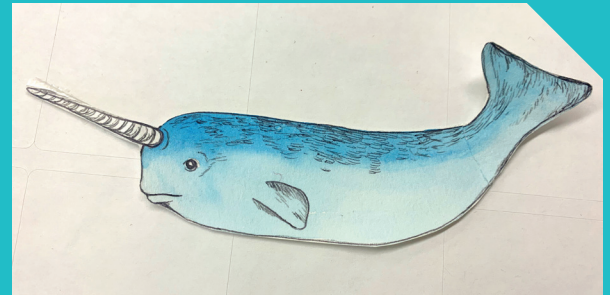
