WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS:


- Please allow 2-3 weeks to process all refunds.

MONDAY, MARCH 25

MORNING: 9:00AM - 12:00PM

SPOOKY SELFIES WITH SHERRI AGES: 6-9, 9-12
Learn to work with graphite, pencil crayon and sharpies as you draw inspiration from the fun and fascinating works of Tim Burton to create a self portrait. Bring your images to life with lines, shapes, and value!


AND

Learn to work with oil pastels to create colourful and unique works of art. Experiment with juicy colours, shape, and line to create jewel-like treasures.

Explore ocean themes with colourful watercolours; draw, paint, and play with fun textures & tools as you learn about lines and to create volume and three-dimensional effects in your drawings & paintings.

Develop techniques in drawing and cartooning as Sherri helps you learn about the Japanese style Kawaii (AKA - cute style). Work with spring themes to create adorable drawings using markers.
